Consultation on URA's Regulatory Reporting Requirements Closes on 30 April

As announced in March, the Utilities Regulatory Authority (URA) is gathering feedback on its Regulatory Reporting Requirements Issues Paper until 30 April 2012.

The paper seeks comments on issues raised by the Authority in particular: the general principles for regulatory reporting; the application of the rules and definition of regulatory reporting and the nature and form of information to be provided to the Authority for the purpose of regulatory reporting.

The URA was set up under the *Utilities Regulatory Authority Act No. 11 of 2007*. The Authority acts independently of the Government and its primary purpose is to increase access to safe, reliable and affordable electricity and water services, and to protect the long-term interests of consumers

throughout Vanuatu. In the electricity sector, the Authority monitors the concessions operated by UNELCO in Malekula, Port Vila and Tanna; and Vanuatu Utilities and Infrastructure Ltd (VUI) in Luganville. In addition, the Authority manages consumer disputes and advises the Government on matters related to electricity and water. It also reviews tariffs under the rules of the Concessions Agreements and relevant legislation.
